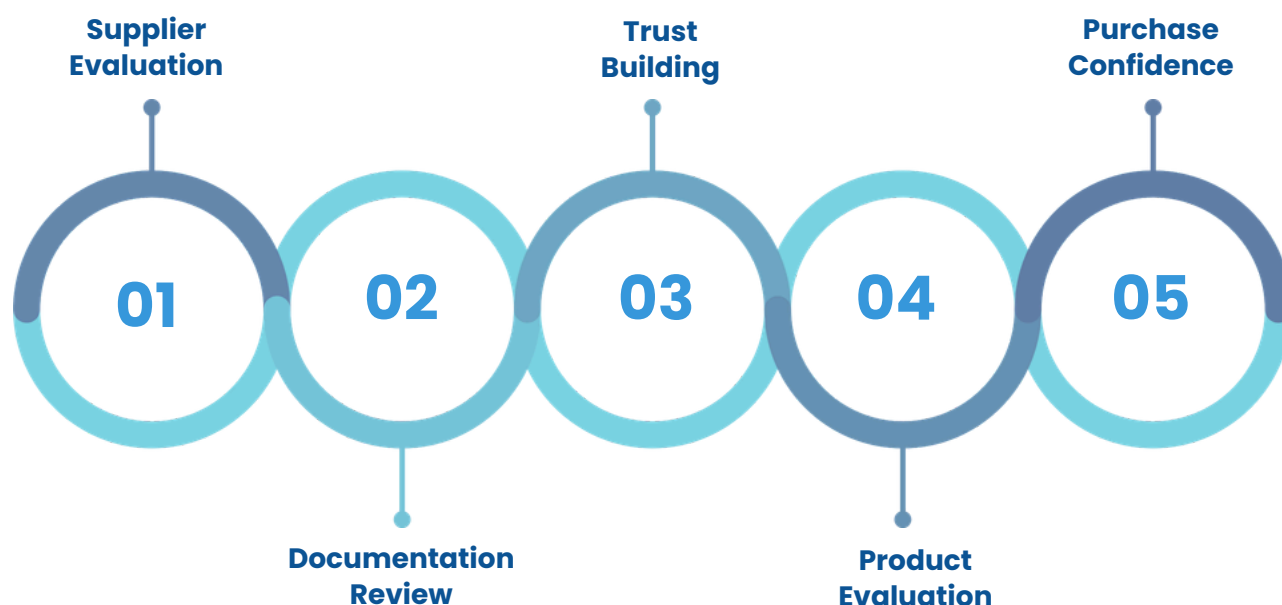

04. Documentation Request Guide

Before placing an order, consider requesting the following documentation from your supplier.

1. Product Documentation

- Certificate of Analysis (COA)
- Product Specification Sheet
- Safety Documents (where available)
- Batch Information

2. Question To Ask

- What documentation is available?
- How is documentation provided?
- Is batch information available?
- What storage requirements apply?
- What is the support process?

07. Common Buyer Mistakes

Avoid these common mistakes to maintain structured and compliant research procurement records.



Mistake #01: Ordering Before Reviewing Documentation

Always request and review available COA, specification sheets, and batch details before placing any order. Documentation review should always precede purchase.



Mistake #02: Failing to Record Batch Information

Batch numbers, lot references, and testing dates form a critical part of research procurement records. Always record this information upon receipt.



Mistake #03: Not Reviewing Storage Requirements Before Delivery

Storage requirements should be reviewed and appropriate storage prepared before the order arrives. Improper handling on receipt can affect documentation integrity.



Mistake #04: Keeping Incomplete Purchasing Records

A complete purchasing record includes supplier details, product name, order date, batch reference, documentation received, and storage notes.



Mistake #05: Comparing Suppliers Without a Structured Checklist

Unstructured supplier comparison leads to inconsistent evaluation. Use a checklist to compare transparency, documentation, support, and procurement readiness fairly.

08. Continue Your Evaluation Process

Use this guide alongside product documentation, batch details, supplier information, and research-use-only product review pages.
